Colosseum Battle Mode:

- * Colosseums: There are 11 Colosseums (Battle Arenas) altogether throughout Pokétopia. The first 10 are used for battles, while the 11th is used for the Colosseum Masters.
- * Colosseum Masters: These excellent Trainers are also first-class entertainers whose amazing battles are a sight to behold.
- * Colosseum Leaders: With their awesome strength and skills, Colosseum Leaders rank right behind the Colosseum Masters.

Nintendo DS Battle Mode: This multiplayer mode is for those who also own Pokémon Diamond or Pokémon Pearl.

Wi-Fi Battles: Players battle against their friends via Nintendo Wi-Fi Connection after exchanging Friend Codes.

Battle Passes and Trainer Customization: Players can create and customize their own Battle Pass by trading.
